



An Architectural gem in the Lake County, Florida Community. William J. Howey purchased 60,000 Acres in 1920 in Lake County founding the town that was to bear his name.

In 1924 he and his wife Mary Hastings Howey completed the plans for their permanent home in Howey in the Hills, and by the end of 1927, the show place was finished, furnished and occupied.

The Architect was Katherine Cotheal Budd.

Designed in Mediterranean Revival Style and situated on 15 Acres, the home is set back on a wide lawn approached through wrought iron gates.
